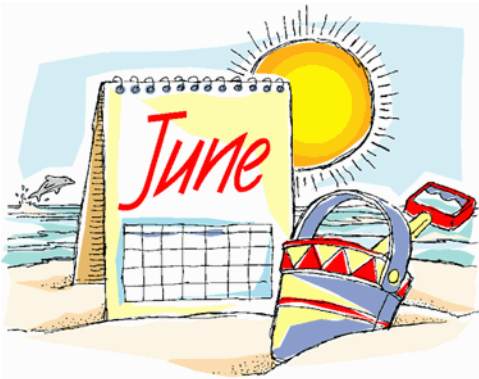

Flag Day

In the United States, **Flag Day** is celebrated on **June 14th**. It commemorates the adoption of the flag of the **United States**, which happened on that day in 1777 by resolution of the Second Continental Congress. **The United States Army also celebrates the Army Birthday on this date**; Congress adopted "the American continental army" on June 14, 1775. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that officially established June 14 as Flag Day; in August 1949,

National Flag Day was established by an Act of Congress. Flag Day is not an official federal holiday; it is at the President's discretion to officially proclaim the observance.

Bob and Deacon Bill under the guidance of Bishop Atwood, as well as the Advisors and the office staff.
