### **National Day of Prayer**


Thanks to all who attended the National Day of Prayer breakfast at the Rockwall

### **June 2, 2019 - Sunday after Ascension Day, Blood Drive, First Sunday Celebration, & VBS Team Orientation**



On **Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>**, we will celebrate the **Feast of the Ascension**, which falls on the 40th day of Easter. This holy day commemorates the bodily ascension of Jesus into heaven. The collect for this day is: “Almighty God, whose blessed Son our Savior Jesus Christ ascended far above all heavens that he might fill all things: Mercifully give us faith to perceive that, according to his promise, he abides with his Church on earth, even to the end of the ages; through Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, in glory everlasting.” **Amen.**

This Sunday also brings us another opportunity to save lives through **donating much-needed blood to Carter BloodCare**. The Bus will be open for business from **9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m.** We need 24 attempts to give in order to obtain sufficient credit to keep the Bus coming out to us. Even if you end up being denied, your attempt does count. If you did not sign up previously, walk-ins are welcome. **Thank you!**

### Pentecost Sunday



This year, the **fiftieth day of Easter, Pentecost, falls on Sunday, June 9<sup>th</sup>**. This is the Sunday when we commemorate the **descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Christ**. We wear red this day to remind us of the **joy and fire of the Holy Spirit** in our lives.

The season of Pentecost, which begins on Pentecost Sunday, is often referred to as “Ordinary Time”. It is the last season of our liturgical year, and it extends through the last Sunday of Pentecost/Christ the King Sunday in November. The liturgical color for the season of Pentecost is green which traditionally represents growth, especially in faith. The collect for Pentecost Sunday is: “Almighty God, on this day you opened the way of eternal life to every race and nation by the promised gift of your Holy Spirit: Shed abroad this gift throughout the world by the preaching of the Gospel, that it may reach to the ends of the earth.” **Amen.**

We will have two guests with us for worship this day - **The Rev. Dr. Roger Frye and The Rev. Bates Richmond**. We appreciate their support and we welcome them!

## Flag Day

In the United States, **Flag Day is celebrated on June 14<sup>th</sup>**. It commemorates the adoption of the flag of the **United States**, which happened on that day in 1777 by resolution of the Second Continental Congress. **The United States Army also celebrates the Army Birthday on this date**; Congress adopted "the American continental army on June 14, 1775. In 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that officially established June 14 as Flag Day; in August 1949, National Flag Day was established by an Act of Congress. Flag Day is not an official federal holiday; it is at the President's discretion to officially proclaim the observance.



## TAC Concert Series and Artists' Reception

## Sunday, June 16 – Trinity Sunday and Bishops' Reception

**Trinity Sunday**, the **first Sunday after Pentecost**, falls this year on **June 16<sup>th</sup>**. On this day, we honor the Trinity, the three Persons of God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. This is one of the few celebrations of the Christian Year that recognizes a reality and doctrine rather than a person or event. The collect for this day is: "Almighty and everlasting God, you have given to us your servants grace, by the confession of a true faith, to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and in the power of your divine Majesty to worship the Unity: Keep us steadfast in this faith and worship, and bring us at last to see you in your one and eternal glory, O Father; who with the Son and the Holy Spirit live and reign, one God, for ever and ever."




**Amen.**




***The Order of St. Luke the Physician is an inter-denominational, international ministry for healing of body, mind and spirit.***

**“He sent forth his word and healed them; he rescued them from the grave. Let them give thanks to the Lord for his unending love and his wonderful deeds for men.” Psalm 107:2**

God’s word is so important to us all. He spoke his word and created the heavens and the earth. He speaks forth the word and the earth can be saved from terrifying disasters. His word can turn our lives around and cause us to be repentant and bring

changes to our whole families, our churches and our country. The Lord can speak a word and bring miraculous healings to the sick and dying. Do we believe that? I do. Does He always answer? He always answers, but not always in the way we would like. At that point all I can do is trust His Wisdom and keep asking.



After all, Jesus, Himself teaches us to be persistent in Luke 11:5-8 when he speaks about a man who went to his friend and asked for bread because another friend who was on a journey stopped by to see him. The friend of whom he asked for help did not want to get up out of bed to give the man the bread, but because he was persistent, the friend did. And in Luke 18:1-8, he gives a parable to show that we should keep asking until the Lord gives us an answer to our request.

Some may think that I must have much faith and trust because I am the convener (leader) of the Order of St. Luke at Transformation; however, my faith and trust is no more than yours. I do not always obey the Lord when he speaks to me and sometimes, my faith is very weak; my trust unsure. My husband and I have just gone through his surgery for heart problems and at times, I was unsure of the future and found myself rebuking the evil one for his lies about what would happen. So you see, your faith and trust do not have to be enormous to pray for others, you just have to be sincere. Those of us who are members of OSL are sincere when we pray for you. We really want you to be well and whole, whether the need is body, mind, or spirit. That is why we study about healing; read God's Word daily (well, almost daily in my case); and study many books on healing written by great authorities. That is why we get together on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month for fellowship, learning, and support for each of our brothers and sisters who serve on prayer teams. That is also why we invite you to go to prayer after taking Communion on Sundays. You just have to walk out the door to the right of the altar and someone in the hallway will direct you to a prayer team waiting to pray for you and your needs.

Have you felt that the Lord is directing you to learn more about OSL and Christian healing? If so, then attend one of the OSL Pot Luck Brunches on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday and see what is going on. We could use a few more men in the ministry, too; after all, this isn't just a woman's thing. Our meetings start at 10:00 with brunch and then we have teaching and a short meeting followed by prayer. I really hope to see you there on June 15 in the Parish Hall of the church. Everyone is welcome.
